

We put international students, adoptees, refugees, expats and travellers side by side to share stories which uncovered stories of identity, belonging, family, home, integration, business and social entrepreneurship. These stories showed how we are all connected through migration.

Throughout the years we have designed and implemented multiple international collaboration projects that embrace our values and goals. We believe exchange of knowledge and experiences across borders and disciplines is the only way to create a more inclusive future.

1. Share

Share stories from migrants and travellers to educate and combat existing stereotypes and prejudice.

Design

Design media tools which examine and map the inter-connectivity of migration and tourism into a personal and historical context.

3. Empower

Empower and train relevant stakeholder to become storytelling changemakers.

4. Co-create

Co-create new solutions for a more cohesive society.

Budget 2022

For 2022, total donations and grants are budgeted at \leqslant 11,000. Also selling Roots Guide will start this year (expected income \leqslant 2,000) . This, together with the available cash at banks and in hand as at December 31, 2021, will be used to execute activities/projects like Roots Guide (\leqslant 26,000) and Rural Migrantour (\leqslant 3,800); an amount of \leqslant 1,500 is budgeted for operational expenses.

As was the case for 2021, the donations/grants budgeted for 2022 are not expected to be of a recurring nature.

The available cash at banks and in hand as at December 31, 2021 has been earmarked and will be fully spent for projects in 2022/2023 and is as such not freely available. The equity, equaling to the cash at banks and in hand as at December 31, 2021, is therefore not freely available and has therefore been presented as "semi-restricted funds" in the balance sheet as at December 31, 2021.

Accounting policies used in preparing the financial statements

General

The registered office according to the Articles of Association of Stichting Pocket Stories is in Amsterdam. Stichting Pocket Stories is registered in the Commercial Register of the Chamber of Commerce under the file number: 66886090.

The address of Stichting Pocket Stories is Essenstraat 9B, 2011 DW Haarlem.

The financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2020 have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Guidelines for Annual Reporting 640 "Not-for-profit organisations" (RJ 640) of the Dutch Accounting Standards Board. The financial statements were prepared on

Objective of the foundation

The objectives of the foundation are: to initiate, cooperate with and support projects related to storytelling on a personal and intercultural level and in the field of education, to promote cultural diversity and to improve understanding of migration in any way.

Cash at bank and in hand

Cash at bank and in hand includes cash in hand, bank balances, notes and cheques and carried at face value. It also includes deposits if these are effectively at the foundation's free disposal, even if interest income may be lost.

Cash at bank and in hand not expected to be at the foundation's free disposal for longer than twelve months is classified as financial assets under the non-current assets. Cash at bank and in hand are carried at face value.

Equity

Stichting Pocket Stories does not have any equity; the result for the financial year will be used to finance project related activities and as such the cumulated result is presented as semi-restricted funds, being funds earmarked for activities related to a certain topic/objective and agreed upon with third parties, but not limited to specific projects.

Current liabilities

On initial recognition, current liabilities are carried at fair value less directly attributable transaction costs. After initial recognition, current liabilities are carried at amortized cost. This is usually the face value for current liabilities.

Income

General

Income represents the proceeds from providing services, grants, sponsor contributions, donations and income from fundraising and other income. Income is recognized in the statement of income and expenditure, taking into account the accounting policies used and are allocated to the financial year to which they relate.

Income in kind in the form of goods or services are recognized at fair value in the statement of income and expenditure.

Services

If the result of a transaction relating to a service can be reliably estimated and the income is probable to be received, the income relating to that service is recognized in proportion to the service delivered. Stage of completion is based on the costs incurred in providing the services up to the balance sheet date in proportion to the estimated costs of the total services to be provided.

Grant income

Grant income is recognized as soon as there is reasonable certainty that the stated conditions will be met and the grant will actually be obtained.

Expenses

General

Expenses are determined with due observance of the aforementioned accounting policies and allocated to the financial year to which they relate.

Interest

Interest is allocated to successive financial reporting periods in proportion to the outstanding principal. Premiums and discounts are treated as annual interest charges so that the effective interest rate, together with the interest payable on the loan, is recognized in the income statement, with the amortized (net) cost of the liabilities being recognized in the balance sheet. Period interest expense and similar related expenses are recognized in the year in which they fall due.

Workforce

The average number of staff (in FTE's) employed by the foundation in 2021 was nil (2020: nil).
